

Because the site is located only a short distance from Town Police Headquarters, emergency response time should be minimal. Captain Deborah Maselli of the Volunteer Ambulance Corps, which is located at 1 Westlake Drive, indicated that the response time would be 3 to 7 minutes. Commissioner Ken Hoffarth of the Valhalla Fire Department indicated that the response time would be 4 to 12 minutes with the majority being 4 to 6 minutes (within the NFPA standard).

j. Westchester County Emergency Evacuation Plan (Indian Point)

Information for this section was obtained from the "Community Guide for Indian Point: A Guide for You and Your Family," published by the Westchester County Office of Emergency Services.

Mount Pleasant and the Westchester University site are more than ten miles from Indian Point, and there are no Emergency Response Planning Areas within the study area. The Valhalla High School and Middle Schools have been designated as a School Reception Center for St. Columanus Elementary School, and a General Population Reception Center for three Emergency Response Planning Areas in the Town of Cortlandt.

Because the Westchester University site is not in an Emergency Response Planning Area, there should be only an insignificant amount of site-generated traffic to mix with the traffic destined for the Valhalla High School and Middle Schools reception center.
